Nominees for this award must be Active Members in good standing. Nominees should display "The High Ideals of Leadership and Dedication to Their Community and the Pennsylvania Building Officials Conference." Judging is based on their involvement in and support of their home community, the regional PENNBOC chapter and the state association. The winner will receive a plaque memorializing this high honor and designation.

This award is named for Pat Campanella, a code enforcement official who spent many years serving the State Executive Committee and his home territory in Region 2. Pat worked hard to promote membership and educational opportunities for our association. He served as State President in 1980 and became the first recipient of this award in 1982.

Nominations close on September first. Judging is done by the Board of Directors and the award is presented at the annual conference in October.
