Description

The purpose of this multi-day course is to train emergency management agency professionals, engineers, architects, and certified building inspectors in post-disaster structural evaluation of buildings and to provide participants with skills, knowledge, and tools to help them become a Disaster Response Inspector.

In the event of a natural disaster, state and local governments may not have the resources on-hand to effectively assess the safety and serviceability of buildings within their jurisdiction in a timely manner. Following these catastrophic events, the government has a need to be able to call upon qualified volunteers with experience and training in building design and construction to structurally assess buildings and vertical structures within their jurisdiction.

Participants will learn the ICC Disaster Response Process, which will enable them to respond to a disaster site prepared to interface with the onsite command structure and become a resource in identifying unsafe buildings and uninhabitable structures. Throughout this interactive course, participants will have the opportunity to practice skills and receive practical information and tools that can be used at the disaster site. **Participants are required to complete pre-work (which will be provided by the ICC) prior to attending the training.** At the conclusion of Day 2 of the course, participants will be given a Proficiency Exam. If a participant passes, they will be issued a Certificate of Proficiency. On the final half day of training, instruction is designed to integrate the information obtained in the When Disaster Strikes seminar with the Pennsylvania state and local response network to better utilize the tier two responder in the field. At the end of the program, the student will better understand the role of the code official in the building evaluation team and the documentation requirements dictated by the state and local government agencies.
